Core Activities and Learning

Refer to the following Bible verses and raise the following questions to the children:

"For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." Mark 10:45

- Who is the Son of Man? How does He serve us?

"Whoever serves me must follow me; and where I am, my servant also will be. My Father will honour the one who serves me." John 12:26

- How can we follow and serve Jesus?

In your answers, you can refer to the following points:

- You can serve God by serving other people with love.
- You can serve God by doing His will with trust in Him.
- You can serve God by using your gifts and talents to the community and the Church.

Refer to examples from the Scriptures of people that served God and obey His will.

e.g. Noah obeyed God and protected his family and the animals.

Moses listened to God and received the 10 commandments of God for His people.

Jesus served God and us by doing what His Father commanded.

Ask the children: Do you know any other person in the Bible that obeyed the will of God and served Him?

Crafty activity: Create a large graffiti paper with the words "I will serve the Lord". Ask children to write words or sentences of how they can serve God.

Resources: The Bible, Mark 10:45, John 12:26

Materials: coloured pens or pencils.

Review: We can serve God by serving others, doing His will and using our gifts and talents for the advance of His kingdom.
