Starter: Guess the word. The teacher writes a word to a piece of paper and gives it to one child from the group. The child will have to describe the word by using the right actions to the rest of the group that must guess the word.

Learning objectives: To understand the importance of using the right actions to make Jesus known to people that don't know Him.

Core Activities and Learning

Say that the game we played in the beginning helped us understand the importance of using the right action to describe the word. The same way, God wants us to use the right actions to show to other people God's love for them.

God wants us to "speak the truth in love", but sometimes actions are more powerful than words. E.g. Be hospitable to people, pray for them, support them through difficult times.

Explain that we can be both: be bold in confessing our faith using the right words but demonstrate God's love with the right action as well. Don't sacrifice one for the other.

God wants us to demonstrate gentleness and respect (1 Pet. 3:15). Whether they agree with you or not, people appreciate being respected as persons.

Only the Holy Spirit of God can regenerate a sinful heart, but we can inspire and encourage another person to learn more about Jesus and leave the results to Him.

Crafty activity:

Cut the following statements and ask children to create a flower from paper. In every petal of the flower the children will write inside one of the following 'right actions' they can do to become a good example of Jesus to others. See example on the link below.

Resources: The Bible, 1 Pet. 3:15

Review: God wants us to be an example of Jesus love not only with words, but with the right actions that will draw someone closest to Him.
