Starter: Bring in the classroom the picture of a homeless person, a lonely child sitting by himself at school, someone that is sick, someone that is in prison. **Ask** children: What does this man/child or woman needs?

Learning objectives: To understand the importance of helping other people and offering them the right support.

Core Activities and Learning

Ask children: How does Jesus meet the needs you discussed?

Read from the Bible: John 6:25-40 and Matthew 6:25-34

Ask children: Who is the 'bread of life'?

In your answers, you can refer to the following:

- The first thing that you can highlight is that we need Jesus more than anything else.
- God can provide everything we need and take care of all our needs, but we need to know Him first and invite Him in our lives.
- That's why it is very important to introduce Jesus to people, because He is our Saviour and loves everyone.
- Our mission is to be an example to other people of how God is taking care of us, because we put our trust in Him.
- Jesus is the "Bread of Life", that means that God is the one that cover all our physical and spiritual needs.
- Jesus is offering to us Himself through the Holy Communion.

Group activity: Draw the figure of a human body and write inside with the help of children the physical and emotional needs of a human. Then complete the picture writing at the top the title "Jesus can cover all our needs".

Resources: The Bible, John 6:25-40 and Matthew 6:25-34

Review: What we all need is Jesus Christ and His teaching.

Follow Up: Why do we need Jesus to cover all our needs?
