**Prayer:** O Heavenly King, O Comforter, the Spirit of truth, who art in all places and fillest all things; Treasury of good things and Giver of life: Come and dwell in us and cleanse us from every stain, and save our souls, O gracious Lord.

**Starter:** Ask the children: When you have a question in school, who do you ask? Why? When you have a question about God and about your faith, who do you ask?

Learning objectives: To learn how church can help us with the questions we have about God and our Christian faith.

## **Core Activities and Learning**

**Introduction:** Say that today we are going to find out how church can help us with the questions we have about God and our Christian faith.

## The ways that Church can help us are:

- Through the teaching of the Word of God in the Holy Scripture.
- Through the teaching of the Fathers of the Church.
- Through Sunday school.
- Through the preaching and advise of the priest.
- Through the advises and support of older people, who can be more mature in their faith.

Ask children: Why is it important to get answers on the questions around our Christian faith?

**In your answer**, you can include the following: my faith becomes stronger; I am more confident on my identity as Christian; I am more confident in talking about Jesus to other people, because I have better knowledge and understanding of my Christian faith.

**Group activity:** Pass to the class white sheets of paper. Ask from the children to write individually any questions they might have on the Christian Faith. They can decorate the sheet based on their preference, to make the activity more enjoyable. Encourage the children to seek answers from the priest, their parents and other adults in the church. Explain to the children that they have to bring their sheet next week with the answers they have found and share the information with the rest of the class.

Resources: The Holy Scriptures and the Church Fathers.

Materials: coloured pens or pencils, glue, scissors.

**Review:** The Church can help us on our faith questions through the Holy Scriptures, the Church Fathers, the priest and other Christian adults.

Follow Up: Have you found answers to the questions you wrote last week on your personal sheet? Share them with the class.
