Starter: Ask children: who is your best friend? Do you know if he or she is a Christian?

Learning objectives: To learn how church can help us make Christian friends and how we can develop our Christian faith through these friendships.

Core Activities and Learning

Ask children: Do you think that church is a good place to make friends? Why?

On your discussion with the class you can **refer** to the following points:

Church is a good place to make friends, as Christians come to worship God;

Church is the place where people are united by their Christian faith;

Making friends is easy, as you probably get to see them every Sunday in the church and then in the Sunday school;

Making friends from the church helps you become stronger in your faith, as you are able to share with other Christians your common faith and understanding of some matters.

Group activity: Pass to the children white sheets of paper and ask them to draw their hand print and write five things that make them a good friend to someone. Discuss with the class the qualities of a good friend.

Resources: The Holy Scriptures.

Materials: coloured pens or pencils, white sheets.

Review: There is no greater reward than building godly friendships. Find someone today that you can start being a godly friend to and express the love of Christ to.
