Prayer: Most blessed Lord, send the grace of Your Holy Spirit on me to strengthen me that I may learn well the subject I am about to study and by it become a better person for Your glory, the comfort of my family and the benefit of Your Church and our Nation. Amen

Starter: Everyone to turn around and greet their next neighbour.

Learning objectives: To explore how loving God in my neighbour as myself involves respecting, caring, and serving each person as if it was me that was expecting such practical love and concern from others.

Core Activities and Learning

1. Leader to start with the reading of **Matthew 25:31-46** "Parable of the Sheep and the Goats". Explain how everything we do to our neighbour we do onto God as we are created in His image. **Genesis 1:27:** "So God created man in his own image, in the image of God".
2. Activity 1: Students to get in a circle and each have a turn to say one way in which they can show their love to their neighbour.
3. Activity 2: Self-reflection on whether we think we do enough to show our love daily.
4. Question: Who is our neighbour.
5. Leader to read **Luke 10:25-37** "Parable of the Good Samaritan". And explain how Everyone, whether they are kind to us or not, whether they are our friend or enemy whether they are of the same race or from the same region as us or not Are all our neighbour.

Resources: print outs of the parables

Review: Golden rule: do unto others as you would have them do unto you. We show our love to God in service to our neighbours. One way of achieving this is in 5 simple daily steps: by listening, with generosity, by encouraging, with acts of kindness and by praying for others.

Follow Up: Show love to a random neighbour after lesson.
