Prayer and Starter: The Lord's Prayer

Learning objectives: To understand that God speaks to us in many different ways today.

Icebreaker: Chinese whispers. Ask - How well good are you at listening?

Core Activities and Learning

Introduction: Our story today describes how Samuel was eager to serve God with his whole heart from a very young age.

Read 1 Samuel 3:1-10

Discussions Questions:

1. Who did Samuel minister before while he was still just a boy? (The Lord)
2. What happened as Samuel began to go to sleep for the night? (The Lord called "Samuel")
3. What did Samuel do when he heard his name called? (Answered "Here I am" and ran to Eli)
4. How many times did this happen before Eli realized it was the Lord calling Samuel? (Three)
5. Was Samuel obedient? (Yes, he answered the Lord, just as Eli had instructed)

Take a moment to explain to the children that we should be obedient just like Samuel, who at a very young age listened to God and followed God with his whole heart.
