Prayer and Starter: The Lord's Prayer

Learning objectives: To understand that God speaks to us in many different ways today.

Icebreaker: Chinese whispers. Ask - How well good are you at listening?

Core Activities and Learning

Introduction: Our story today describes how Samuel was eager to serve God with his whole heart from a very young age.

Read 1 Samuel 3:1-10

Discussions Questions:

- 1. Who did Samuel minister before while he was still just a boy? (The Lord)
- 2. What happened as Samuel began to go to sleep for the night? (The Lord called "Samuel")
- 3. What did Samuel do when he heard his name called? (Answered "Here I am" and ran to Eli)
- 4. How many times did this happen before Eli realized it was the Lord calling Samuel? (Three)
- 5. Was Samuel obedient? (Yes, he answered the Lord, just as Eli had instructed)

Take a moment to explain to the children that we should be obedient just like Samuel, who at a very young age listened to God and followed God with his whole heart.
