## **Core Activities and Learning**

## The words of Jesus on the cross are described as follows:

His prayer to God in behalf of His tormentors "Father forgive them, for they know not what they do" (Luke 23:34)

His reply to the dying thief "Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise" (Luke 23:39-43)

He requested the disciple whom He loved to take care of His mother "Woman, behold your son: behold your mother" (John 19:25-27)

He prayed to God, asking why He had been forsaken" My God, My God, why have you forsaken me?" (Matthew 27:45-47 and Mark 15:34)

He said that He was thirsty "I thirst" (John 19:28)

He declared that it was finished "It is finished" (John 19:30)

He commended His Spirit into the hands of His Father "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit" (Luke 23:46)
