Glossary:

Church, love, gift, death, hearts, Liturgy,

Key:

Salvation is a gift of God. Because of His love, God sent His San to deliver mankind from the sin and death. We find our salvation in the Church, where we become one with Christ. During the Liturgy we sing "let us commend ourselves and one another and our whole life to Christ our God". We imitate Christ in helping the needy. Every help we offer to the other person in this world comes from Christ, and every appeal, addressed to us from another person is addressed from Christ. And because God is love, we should give our love to God and to creatures in same way. St. apostle Paul says God love is in our hearts and the love of Christ controls us.

Activity 3: Church – our ship of salvation

This activity can be organized in two ways:

- 1. Children draw a ship in a rough sea. On a sail they can write "Church". In the boat itself they should write what we find in the Church for example: unity, Christ, love, Eucharist, blessing, Holy Spirit.
- 2. Make a big paper boat. Children should "load" the boat. On small notes should write what we find in the Church (see above). Then you can put the boat in a vessel with water.
