**Prayer and Starter:** Lord, help me to have a clear and strong faith in you so I can confess that: " I am not worthy for you to come under my roof" (7:6) but say the word, and my soul will be healed". (3 minutes)

### Learning objectives:

1. To understand what is faith?
2. To be able to understand the blessing of faith in Jesus
3. To be able to memorise the verse: Luke7:6 -7: " Lord, I am not worthy for you to come under my roof" (7:6) but say the word, and my soul will be healed".

### Core Activities and Learning

1. Leader reads Luke7: 1-10 (4 minutes) Tell the students beforehand that at the end of the session, they will need to focus on 3 characters: Jesus, the Jewish elders and the Centurion.
2. Ask some questions: what did the Jewish elders want Jesus to do and why? Why/ what was Jesus reaction? and what was the centurion last message to Jesus?
3. Ask the student what does faith mean to them?
4. Faith means that we believe in God who we don't experience via our senses. Believe with no doubt that God is always good and we should always be awaiting the greatest and best things from Him. Why? Because he is our Heavenly Father and Jesus taught us to pray " Our Father"
5. Emphasise on the Centurion's role. How he believed that Jesus can heal his servant from distance.
6. How can we have such a good faith? Ask the students then highlight the role of "prayer. Bible, church" in strengthening the faith.
7. The blessing of the faith: read the following and tell the students that the best definition of faith has been given by Jesus in Mark 11:22 "Have faith in God," Jesus said to them. 23 "Truly I tell you that if anyone says to this mountain, 'Be lifted up and thrown into the sea,' and has no doubt in his heart but believes that it will happen, it will be done for him. 24 Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours....  
So the blessing is: to receive whatever we ask for in our prayers whenever they are according to God's Will.
8. Try to memorise the verse:" Lord, I am not worthy for you to come under my roof" (7:6) but say the word, and my soul will be healed".
9. End piece: Keep one minute in silence together. (1 minute) TOTAL: 45 minutes

### Resources / Review / Follow Up

New Testament + printed copies of the reading (in a large font). [Luke 7:1-10.docx]

Review: next week ask each student to recall one key thing that they have learned from the previous week. Follow up: In the coming weeks reinforce the idea of listening in prayer.
