Prayer: "Thank you God for all the churches all around the world and we ask you to protect and bless them now and forever."

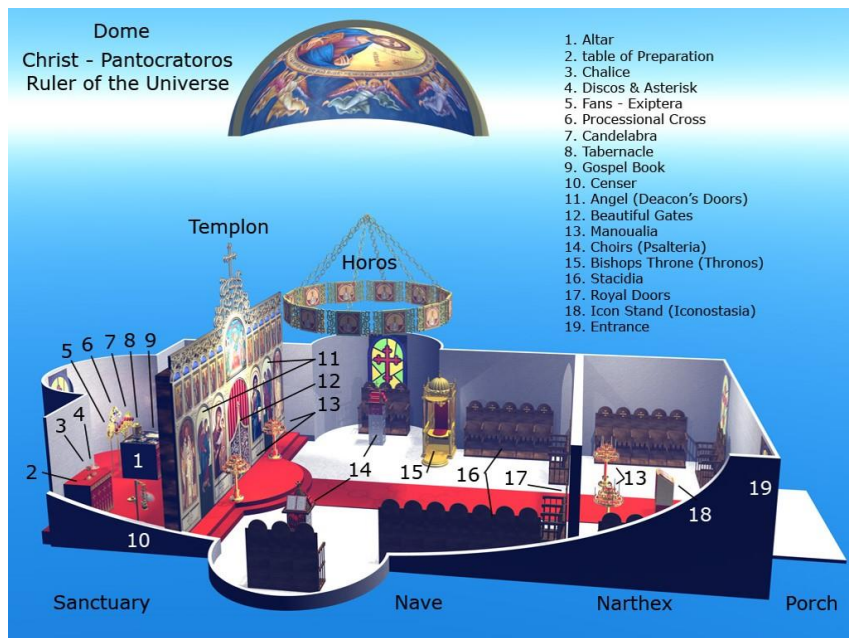
Starter: Ask the students to name as many parts of the Church temple as they can.

Learning objectives: To give a general introduction to the Orthodox church design and make the students aware of its general symbolism.

Core Activities and Learning:

This session will be delivered using the slides either in PPTX or PDF format. If a laptop is not available the slides should be printed.

Print off slide 9 (separate image provided) and distribute it to the students then make a tour of the church to link what is on the paper to what is on the ground and visible. Ask the priest to open the doors.

Review: Remember the main parts of the church building: the narthex, the nave (the temple proper) and the sanctuary (the altar or *holy place*).

Follow Up: Ask the students to keep their eyes on their church design the first time they come to church after this session and try to remember what they have learned.
