Prayer: Trisagion Prayers

Starter: Ask the students to name any liturgical terms they already know and explain their meaning as far as they are able.

Learning objectives: To know some of the more regularly used liturgical terms and their usage in the worship of the Church.

Core Activities and Learning

1. Explain why a familiarity with some basic liturgical terms is very useful for Orthodox Christians.
2. Distribute Resource Sheet 74 together with the word search puzzle on Activity Sheet 74 Puzzle.
3. Deliver the word search solution (Solution Sheet 74) to the students.
4. Ask the students to present a connected explanation of 3 terms that go together from the Resource Sheet. They can work together or individually. The 3 terms must have some connection with each other. Do this until their ideas are exhausted and / or most of the terms covered.

Resources: Resource Sheet 74, Activity Sheet 74 (Puzzle and Solution sheets), Note paper, pens.

Review: Liturgical terms are useful in providing reference points for what we do and why we do certain things in the worship of the Church. A familiarity with their usage gives us a better understanding.

Follow Up: For next week research the Psalter and its use in and out of the temple in Tradition.
