Prayer: The Lord's Prayer.

Starter: What is the connection between Pascha and every Sunday of the Church Year?

Learning objectives: To learn that the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ is being commemorated every year

on Great and Holy Pascha and every week in the Divine Liturgy.

Core Activities and Learning

Refer to the fact that the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead is the centre of the Orthodox Christian faith.

Explain why the Resurrection of Jesus is so important. God has conquered death, triumphed over evil, transformed suffering and forgiven our sins.

Explain that during the Divine Liturgy, in the Eucharist, we offer up ourselves and our gifts to God in Christ in remembrance of all that He has done for us: the cross, the tomb, the resurrection of the third day, the Ascension into heaven, the sitting on the right hand of God the father, and the second and glorious coming again.

Craft activity: Pascha Candles
