Starter: The leader can use the same starter as the one from the previous lesson (see Lesson 56 – Bishop) but this time he can add to the play one more student to act as a second shepherd (he can have a wife) or they can start with WORD LINK as follows: -

This is a word association game. Ask the group to sit in a circle. The first person starts with any word they wish connected with the previous lesson i.e. red. The next person repeats the first word and adds another word which links to the first i.e. vestment. The next person repeats the previous word and add another word link i.e. cross, and so on. To keep this moving, only allow five seconds for each word link. See how many linking words your group can get.

Learning objectives: To know what priest is and what his role is in the Church.

Core Activities and Learning (a priest must be present during this lesson)

1. Leader asks the students what they remember from the previous lesson about the clergy and what the major orders are. Explains that the priest (presbyter) is the second degree of the three major orders.
2. The leader introduces the priest who will have been asked to prepare beforehand a 20 minute talk on his calling, ordination, work and responsibility before God.
3. 20 minutes Q&A with the students.
4. End piece: Keep one minute in silence together.

Resources: Priest

Review: A priest sacrifices his life to be in the image of Christ for his people.

Follow Up: Research the ordination service for a priest online and share the following week any clues you have learned about his role.
