## Prayer: Lord's Prayer

Starter: If you were given £1,000 what would you do with it?

## Learning objectives:

To understand the Church's teaching on Christian Stewardship, that is our responsibility to give to God's work through His Church.

## **Core Activities and Learning**

- 1. Leader explains the biblical teaching in Resource Sheet 52.
- 2. Students complete the Word Search on Activity Sheet 52. There are 13 words to find and these are all mentioned on Resource Page 52.
- Leader splits the students into two groups, A and B. Group A is tasked with listing those things that stop people from being generous. Group B is tasked with listing those things that help a person to become more generous. Both groups should consider spiritual issues, but especially Group B.
- 4. After about 15 minutes, the Leader asks each person in Team A to state ONE obstacle to generosity. Volunteer(s) from Team B then say which of the principles on that list addresses that issue. The points are declared and addressed one at a time between the two teams. The Leader should ensure that the spiritual issues are addressed.

Resources: Resources Sheet 52, Activity Sheet 52, pens / pencils.

**Review:** Giving to God's work through His Church should be a priority when a Christian household plans its expenditures. We give out of what God gives us so that the Church's work might be strengthened and developed.

Follow Up: For next week find out how your own parish finances its work.
