Prayer: Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world have mercy on us. Amen

Starter: The Ten Commandments were originally written on tablets of stone. Which would be best today, stone or digital media? (Trick Question – Stone, the lifetime of digital media is a maximum of 1000 years (M-Disc technology). Provided that it is not exposed to the elements, stone engraving can last hundreds of millennia.

Learning objectives: - To understand some facts about the Ark of the Covenant and its theological significance.

- To understand the symbol of the Ark and its meaning in the Old and New Testament

Core Activities and Learning

- Present the slides and ensure the students can both understand and recall. (The Ark of the Covenant)
- Complete Worksheet 62 (The Ten Commandments).
- Remind the students about some of the New Testament commandments Matthew 22:36: Once an expert of the law asked Jesus: "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbour as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."
- Return to the last slide "As the Ark was the only place Old Testament believers could go (through the high priest) to have their sins forgiven, so Christ is now the only way to salvation and the kingdom of heaven."

Review: As God gave Moses the 10 Commandments and asked him to put them in a safe and secure place. Today God asks each one of us to keep His greatest commandment "Love" in our heart and spread it around us.
