Prayer: Trisagion Prayers

Starter: How does grafting work when growing vines (explain if the students do not know).

Learning objectives: To understand that holiness is a work of Christ within us by the power of the Spirit. Only when we cooperate with this Divine Life within us can we grow and be fruitful – which is holiness.

Core Activities and Learning

1. Read together John 15: 1-17, section by section, (Resource Sheet 67) slowly and ensuring through Q&A that the students understand what Christ is teaching here. This is a group exercise.
2. As an individual exercise, answer the follow up questions given after the text.
3. In a plenary session, the group shares its insights with one another.

Resources: Resource Sheet 67, pens

Review: Christ life within us and our cooperation with Him is the only way that we can grow and be fruitful as Christians.

Follow Up: Mediate on Galatians 2:20 during the next week. How is this text connected? What are the implications for my life as a Christian?
