Prayer: Read or sing together: Troparion - Tone 3

Shining with the rays of divine light, O venerable Andrew, You knew Christ the wisdom and power of God. By means of the image of the Holy Trinity You preached to all the world the Holy Trinity in unity. And we, with amazement and joy, cry out to you: As you have boldness before the Most Holy Trinity Pray that the Uncreated Light May illumine our souls!

Starter: Ask students: do they know any iconographer saints? Say a LITTLE about St Luke.

Learning objectives: To have a general biographical knowledge of St. Andrei Rublev; how he became a saint and his contribution to the life and witness of the Orthodox Church

Core Activities and Learning

The leader tells or reads the biography/story or other readings of St. Andrei Rublev.

Discuss the life and ministry of St Andrei in small groups and record the findings presenting these to class. What lessons can be learned from the witness of the saint?

The Leader shows St Andrei Rublev's icon "The Hospitality of Abraham."

Use Resource Sheet 56 to explain the Trinitarian symbolism.

The students colour their own icon of the Hospitality. The object is to reproduce the original as faithfully as possible.

Read or preferably sing together: Kontakion - Tone 2

Like a trumpet, you clearly sounded the sweetness of divine hymns, and were revealed as a brilliant beacon shining on the world with the light of the Trinity. Therefore, we all cry to you, venerable Andrei: "Unceasingly pray for us all."
