1. To trust in the Lord means more than believing in who He is and what He says. To trust is to place your confidence only in God. To trust is to acknowledge God in everything. Acknowledging God means knowing God wherever we are and whatever we are doing. Jeremiah 17 gives us clarity:

“Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord,
whose trust is the Lord.

He is like a tree planted by water,
that sends out its roots by the stream,
and does not fear when heat comes,
for its leaves remain green,
and is not anxious in the year of drought,
for it does not cease to bear fruit. (7-8)

2. “By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.” (Hebrew 11:7)
